Looking for a new way to ski? Try Snowcats

If you're looking for a new ski or snowboard experience, you might give Pacific Crest Snowcats a try.

Pacific Crest Snowcats is Lake Tahoe's only snowcat assisted backcountry skiing and snowboarding service.

Skiers and boarders can explore deep into the backcountry on terrain not

ordinarily accessible to them, with EMT-trained guides, who are also experienced in avalanche forecasting and control.

What can you expect on a Pacific Crest Snowcats trip?

According to PCS, "Skiers and boarders can experience the best snow conditions in the area in our steep north facing runs.

"The terrain we now visit initially inspired our operation; and you too will be inspired when you visit. Our open slopes and tree runs will remind you of the best off piste areas at your favorite ski resort.

"Our longest run is 1,500-foot (our average run length is 1,200 vertical feet) and begins near 8,000-foot through nicely spaced trees and long vertical clearings left by historic logging crews.

"Our spring corn is managed to provide smooth corn throughout the late season. Our steep terrain is second to none in the area and has entertained some of the best snowboarders and skiers around."

Full day or multiple day backcountry ski and snowboard adventures are available.

Full day adventures start at

8 a.m. and end around 5p.m.

Your full day includes guides, safety instruction, safety gear, lunch, a full day of skiing, and a premium beverage for the last snowcat ride of the day.

Access is limited to 12 guests per snowcat, and seats will be filled on a "first come, first served" basis.

A 50 percent non-refundable deposit is required to reserve your seats.
