## Miller's 2006 film is 'Off The Grid'

BOULDER, Colorado - This fall, journey beyond the edge of winter with Warren Miller's "Off The Grid."

Olympic skier turned NFL football player Jeremy Bloom serves as narrator as the world's best winter sports athletes embark on a global mission to discover the deepest snow, the steepest mountains and the world's gnarliest snowball fight.

"Off The Grid" exposes the undiscovered side of winter from Kashmir, India to Kicking Horse, Canada. 2006 Olympic medalist Toby Dawson and X-Games Gold Medalists Zach and Reggie Crist pack the notable cast of this adrenaline-filled documentary-style film that takes viewers out of the ordinary and into the extraordinary.

"The grid is a metaphor," says Producer/Director Max Bervy. "It represents the boundaries and routines of everyday life. Inversely, "Off The Grid" is a place where nothing is common and everything is possible.

"Off The Grid" is where the romance and soul of the sport come alive in the mountains that we love. It's the place where we redefine boundaries, take risks and search out unique and undiscovered areas

to escape the compromise of everyday life."

How does this film get "Off The Grid"?

Skier Jaime Pierre sets a world-record, by skiing off the edge of a 245-foot snow-covered cliff.

Kevin Bramble and Monte Meier become the first adaptive skiers to tackle the remote, helicopter accessed backcountry of Alaska's Chugach Mountains.

The World Snowball Fighting Championships in Hokkaido, Japan are showcased in an event so bizarre, and "Off The Grid" that verbal explanation cannot do it justice.

Warren Miller's "Off The Grid" tours the country from October to December 2006 as a limited release with stops in more than 180 U.S. cities including New York, Chicago and Los Angeles.

Often arriving in town for one night only, Warren Miller Entertainment's movies mark the official start of winter for hundreds of thousands of adventure junkies yearly.

The films star athletes attend many of the screenings, lending to the films festival atmosphere.

"Off The Grid" is the 57th annual movie from Warren Miller Entertainment, the leaders in action sports film-making.

"Off The Grid" brings fans deeper into the heart of the mountains, touring in true cinematic widescreen as the
